Advanced Bus Driver Course 604.040

This advanced course will offer an opportunity for veteran drivers to recharge their batteries while sharing experiences with other drivers. We will cover current laws and regulations, self-assessment and revisit the basic operations that will help ensure safe student transportation. Take this professional development opportunity to allow your drivers to share, learn and reflect on how they complete their daily tasks.

This Advanced Course is approved through the NYS Education Department and must be taught by a NYSED approved School Bus Driver Instructor (SBDI). Drivers who successfully complete this course may receive a NYSED Advanced Course certificate and will be eligible for NYS DMV Point/Insurance Reduction.

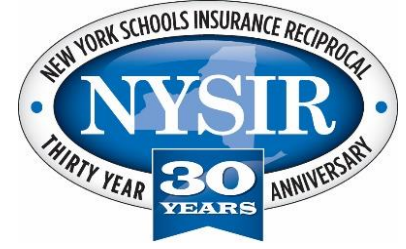
