Automotive Service Technician

- Each student must obtain coveralls or work clothes and appropriate shoes. A locker is provided for storage of these items. <u>SNEAKERS AND SANDALS ARE NOT</u> <u>ALLOWED AFTER THE FIRST WEEK.</u>
- 2. N.Y.S. INSPECTION STATION: Reserved for second year Auto students <u>only.</u> Each student is allowed to bring two vehicles to the Center for State Inspection.
- 3. All students are required by law to wear safety glasses in the shop areas.

 NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 4. Vehicle Repair: All pickup of vehicles and repairs to be done to vehicles must be approved by the instructor **ONE WEEK** prior to the arrival of the vehicle.
- 5. Parts: All parts must be supplied by the student, or prior arrangements for parts must be made with the instructor.

PERSONAL VEHICLES ON CAMPUS

This school does not provide insurance for automobiles stored outside. Your own personal comprehensive insurance must be used if you wish to file a claim. We do not provide insurance on our policy at NCOC for customer or student vehicles.

Vehicles should be locked when they are outside. We are not responsible for damages, so take precautions.

If you return to the Center after hours and wish to enter a vehicle parked outside, you must do so with the knowledge of the night custodian, otherwise you could be treated as a trespasser.

Student vehicles that are brought in to NCOC should be completed within 30 days of their arrival.
