Safety Tips....

- Students must display proper behavior in class. If a student is continuously disruptive, dismissal will occur (and tuition will not be refunded).
- Glass bottles may not be sent with students.
- Elevators and snack machines are not to be used by students.
- Elementary students are either picked up by family only in Human Ecology (HUEC) at the end of each seminar (11:30), or ride the bus if your district provides transportation to this program.
- Students will not be permitted to walk alone on campus at any time.

About the program...

The elementary, middle and high school Enrichment Seminar Program offers students a variety of opportunities to pursue their interests in the arts, humanities, and physical activities over the course of four Saturday morning seminars. (The S.A.T. Prep course is six Saturdays.) Each seminar begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends promptly at 11:30 a.m. Students should not arrive before 8:45 a.m. Individuals who are not enrolled in the Enrichment Seminar Program, i.e. friends or relatives, are NOT permitted to attend.

The seminars take place at the State Campus, College at Oneonta or virtually. All elementary students report to HUEC (Human Ecology) to meet with the Program Coordinator and the instructors at the beginning of each seminar, and are then escorted to their classrooms. (S.A.T. students are virtual via Zoom.)

Parents or guardians picking up their children are required to meet their students in HUEC at 11:30. For safety reasons, we do not allow students to meet parents at any other place on campus. **All students must be picked up by 11:30**. As other organizations often use the premises after, and in conjunction, with us, timely pickups are imperative and appreciated.

The Study Council does not provide transportation. Some school districts provide bus transportation to the Enrichment Seminar Program, while others do not. It is your responsibility to check with your school district to determine whether or not they provide transportation to this program. If a student arrives on a bus provided by your school district, that student must be sent home on the same bus unless a note from a parent or guardian is sent with specific alternate pick-up instructions. Such notes are to be given to the Program Coordinator at the morning meeting. A duplicate note from a parent or guardian should also be given to the bus driver when any change in transportation is taking place. Liability factors do not allow us to grant exceptions to this procedural safeguard.

Students who drop out will be charged full tuition unless notification is received from the school district before the respective registration deadlines.
