



TASC Preparation Program Entrance Application

This application form does not guarantee admission to the TASK Preparation Program. Students are required to take the TASC Readiness Assessment and earn enough points that the likelihood of passing the TASC is 50% or higher to enter the program. Students are required to have a math and reading level of 9th grade or higher. Students who do so may also be required to secure a variance from NYSED before they can participate in the program. Depending on the program location, some students will be required to successfully complete an interview with the Counselor and Administrator. All students will be asked to sign an agreement for the location stating they understand and agree to abide by the agreement before final consideration is given for admission.

Prior to admission into the TASC Preparation Program, a student may be required to attend a personal interview with program staff. In addition, Component School Officials may be required to submit an application for variance if the student has made substantial progress toward graduation requirements.
