User agreement for student computer devices

In accepting this chromebook/laptop and charger you are agreeing to adhere to the ONC BOCES Electronic Telecommunications Agreement in the Student Handbook. All students issued computer devices and other equipment are bound by the ONC BOCES Code of Conduct and information contained in the Student Handbook. You must comply with the terms stated in this agreement and the Student Handbook. Failure could result in disciplinary consequences and repossession of any ONC BOCES property.

Laptop/chromebooks can only be utilized for program specific tasks, assignments, and functions. Students are prohibited from installing any software, running any programs not assigned by the instructor, or otherwise using laptop/chromebooks for non-school related functions. Students are prohibited from using laptop/chromebooks for personal reasons and must abide by the Access to Electronic Telecommunications language contained in the Student Handbook.

Students have no expectation of privacy for anything contained within and/or stored in the laptop/chromebook, which is considered school property, regardless of location of the laptop/chromebook.

Each student must take extreme care and caution when handling their laptop/chromebook. The student will be responsible for the reasonable cost of repair or its replacement cost should intentional or negligent damage occur. All laptop/chromebooks have been inspected and

found to be in working order with no damage prior to it being issued to the student. Damage must be reported to administrative personnel immediately.
