## Welding & Metal Fabrication

I would like to welcome all students to the welding program at the Northern Catskills Occupational Center. I would like to remind you of these few items below. These items can be purchased anywhere you choose. Air Gas in Oneonta will discount most items to NCOC students.

- 1. Steel Toe workbooks are required and are **MANDATORY** for shop work. **NO SNEAKERS**
- 2. Long sleeved work shirt *or* leather welding jacket **MANDATORY** for shop for work
- 3. Notebook and pens MANDATORY
- 4. 16' tape measure **MANDATORY** for shop work
- 5. Shop overalls or long pants (Jeans) are recommended
- 6. Welding helmet
- 7. Welding gloves

### WELDING GRADING POLICY

Numerical grades will be calculated for each quarter of the year. This grade will be determined by the following formula:

- 1. 60% of the quarterly grade is based on all the evaluations for the quarter. Evaluations include but are not limited to, unit tests; quizzes, skill tests, worksheets, questions and projects, and evaluation of shop or lab skills.
- 2. 40% of the quarterly grade is based on the average of <u>daily</u> performance or work ethic. Work ethic is based on but not limited to, team work; cooperation, reliability, dependability, work quality, precision accuracy; response to criticisms; punctuality; time management; work pace; safety; professional manner and personal appearance.
- 3. Final grade is the average of the sum of the four quarters and the **final exam** for each year.

#### STUDENT RULES & REGULATIONS

Each student will receive a Student Handbook in the mail prior to the first week of school. He/she will be responsible for knowing the rules and complying with them. Good attendance is essential for your success in school.
